Decide if you want to collect on one big day as part of a group event or over the course of several weeks.

Set a Goal and Pick a Theme

Decide what items you want to collect and how many. There are several options and a few "year-round" needs you can find in this packet.

Deliver your Donations

Work with Nash to coordinate your drop off. We want to be sure staff can be there to help, give you a receipt,

and thank you in person. You worked hard on this and we want you to know how much we appreciate it. If you'd like to take a short tour during your drop-off, let Nash know!



Frequently Asked Questions

How long does a drive last?

Decide if you want to collect on one big day as part of a group event or over the course of several weeks. We recommend a minimum of three (3) weeks.

Do you take items outside of the requested ones?

We respectfully ask that you collect things we're looking for. We have a wide variety of needs so be sure to work with Nash on deciding the type of drive best for your group.

How do we get the items to you?

Your donation can be dropped of at Horizon House Monday through Friday from 9am to4pm. We recommend scheduling directly with Nash, especially if you would like a short tour.

Do the items have to be new?

Yes and no. Personal hygiene kits should be new and unused. Snack pack kits should be new and individualized packages. Gently used clothing, sneakers, and belts are totally fine but underwear must be new.

Snack Packs

Every neighbor who visits the Horizon House Service Center receives a snack pack when they leave for the day. Last year, there were over 50,000 visits to the center. That means we have a constant need for assembled snack packs or the items needed to make them.

Snack Packs are built with:

- 1-gallon plastic zip bag
- 3 4 non-perishable snack items (at least one protein item)
 - Tuna pouches, beef jerky sticks, Vienna sausages
 - Protein/Cereal/Chewy granola bars
 - Peanut butter crackers
 - Cheese crackers
 - Fruit cups/Applesauce (with a pull top)
- 1 bottle of water

Housing Kits

Residents at both St. George and Compass on Washington have their own living spaces to clean and keep tidy. They also have access to free laundry facilities.

Cleaning kits are built with:

- 1 laundry basket or cleaning bucket
- 1 sponge
- 1 bottle of all purpose cleaner
- 1 bottle of floor cleaner
- 1 bottle of dish soap
- 1 package of paper towels

Laundry kits are built with:

- 1 laundry basket
- 1 bottle of unscented laundry soap or 1 package of laundry soap pods
- 1 box of unscented fabric softener sheets

Hygiene Kits

With limited access to water and other supplies, neighbors are always in need of basic daily hygiene items.

Hygiene Kits - Male (4-5 items from the list below)

- 1-gallon plastic zip bag
- 1 travel sized deodorant/anti-perspirant
- 1 package of hygiene or baby wipes
- 1 razor
- 1 toothbrush
- 1 travel sized toothpaste
- 1 travel sized can of dry shampoo
- 1 package of dental floss

Hygiene Kits - Female (4-5 items from the list below)

- 1-gallon plastic zip bag
- 1 travel sized deodorant/anti-perspirant
- 1 package of hygiene or baby wipes
- 1 razor
- 1 toothbrush
- 1 travel sized toothpaste
- 1 travel sized can of dry shampoo
- 1 package of dental floss
- 1 package of sanitary napkins or tampons

Outdoor Living Kits

Summer Living

- travel sized insect repellant or wipes
- travel sized sunscreen
- 1 package of hygiene or baby wipes

Winter Living

- blanket
- hats
- scarf
- gloves/mittens
- heavy socks
- hand/foot warmer packets
